

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive 2002/96/EC Compliance Policy

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive 2002/96/EC of the European Parliament stipulates that producers of electrical and electronic equipment are responsible for its reuse, recycling or disposal at the end of its useful life.


Elcometer will discharge its responsibilities under this directive from June 2006 as a member of a WEEE Compliance Scheme and have joined the *B2B Compliance Scheme* operated by GAMBICA.

Elcometer have registered as a producer under this scheme and will provide all relevant information so that B2B can discharge their obligations in respect of WEEE.
